- 1> Jimmy Piersall - Jimmy was the subject of the 1957 film, Fear Strikes Out.
- 2> Cy Young - Cy made his entry into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1937.
- 3> Arizona Diamondbacks - Located in Phoenix, Chase Field has a seating capacity of 48,633.
- 4> A Winner Never Quits - Released in 1986, A Winner Never Quits starred Keith Carradine as Pete Gray.
- 5> Shawn Green - Shawn set the record against the Milwaukee Brewers on May 23, 2002.
- 6> Seattle Mariners - Established in 1977, the Seattle Mariners have never made an appearance at the World Series.
- 7> 1994 - It was the second time in the event's history that the World Series was not played, the first being in 1904.
- 8> St. Louis Cardinals - The St. Louis Cardinals have won 11 World Series.
- 9> Milwaukee Brewers - Attanasio is also a part-owner of the ice-hockey team the Milwaukee Admirals.
- 10> Babe Ruth - Among Babe's many MLB records, he holds the record for career home runs at 714.
- 11> Cal Ripken, Jr. - Cal played his first game on August 10, 1981 for the Baltimore Orioles.
- 12> Lou Gehrig - Lou wore the number 4.
- 13> Yogi Berra - Inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in 1972, Yogi was voted the Most Valuable Player of the American League three times.
- 14> Hoboken, New Jersey - Played in 1886 between the Knickerbocker Club and the New York Nine at Elysian Fields, Hoboken is the location of the first recorded game of baseball.
- 15> Milwaukee Braves - The 1957 Milwaukee Braves captured the franchise's first World Series title since 1914.
